


We'll make a house with a window and a lion's den with a paper lunch bag.

- 1. Measure from the top of the lunch bag 3 ½ inches. Cut off the top 3 ½ inches that you measured. This will be Daniel's house.
- 2. Fold this top in half with the sides together.
- 3. Cut a small window out of the middle.
- 4. Open the bag.
- 5. Cut out the rectangles at the bottom of your paper. This is the floor.
- 6. Put the bag room wall over the floor rectangle. Tape it there.
- 7. Glue the larger one of your Daniel figures near the window so you can see him praying through the window.





Now we'll use the bottom portion of the paper lunch bag for the lion's den.

- 1. Fold the lunch bag top back so that it looks like a cave opening.
- 2. Attach the lions, Daniel (smaller one), and the angel to the 2nd rectangle floor. Fold the tabs back and glue them to the rectangle. Arrange them as you wish.
- 3. Put the rectangle and figures into the bag.
